

# The Away Fan's Stadium Checklist

Everything to sort out before you travel to an away game

Every stadium has its own rules. Show up prepared and skip the rookie mistakes.

## Before You Book

- Confirm game date/time (times can flex for TV)
- Compare ticket prices across a few resale sites
- Decide where to sit — visiting-fan sections vary
- Book a hotel near transit, not just the stadium

## The Bag Policy — check this or risk the gate

- Look up THIS stadium's exact bag rules (don't assume standard)
- Know if clear bags are required, or only small bags allowed
- Check if backpacks are banned (they often are)
- See if there's on-site storage (many have none) — when in doubt, go bagless

## Getting There

- Check if transit reaches the stadium (often faster than driving)
- Note the nearest stop and the walk from it
- Pre-book parking if driving (day-of is pricier)
- Find the rideshare zones + whether tailgating's allowed

## Game Day

- Know when gates open (often 90 min–2 hrs before)
- Check if it's cashless (many are — bring a card)
- Know if outside food/water is allowed
- Arrive early; screenshot your tickets for bad signal

## As a Visiting Fan

- Read the room on wearing your colors
- Have a plan to meet up after (pickup zones get chaotic)
- Build in time to enjoy the city, not just the game
